


Know all men by these presents that I Richard Fenwick of
the City of Washington in the District of Columbia have this
day sold unto the Right Reverend Leonard Neale of the District
aforesaid all my right title and Interest, both in Law and
in Equity in the following Negro Slaves, as bequeathed to
me by my late Brother Bennett Fenwick Deceased or by his
daughter Margaret Fenwick since also deceased, for the Sum
of Two hundred and thirty two Dollars current money of the
United States, which said sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars
I hereby acknowledge this day to have received, that is to say
All my right title and interest in Negro George, Negro Charles
and Negro Stace Given under my hand & Seal this
Twenty eight day of March 1800
