done you, and will attend closely to
y^r Business, you may think I am
slow collecting, but, no person could do
any better, the people has no money &
produce sells for so little - I was in hopes

That I should have collect some before
this, so that I might come up, but I am
loved to stay untill I can have some
thing worth carrying you - I have
the money for my last years rent
ready and will forward it by the
first opportunity, should you wish
it sent by mail let me know

I must come up in course of the
summer - and would come up now
but the times are so hard and traveling
so expensive that causes my postpone-
ment - we are all well
and with respect remain yrs
