I rec<sup>d</sup> a letter from your  
Procurement a few days ago which  
letter ~~was~~ did not come to hand so soon  
as it might have done, on account  
of his directing to post to ~~me~~ <sup>him</sup>, my  
letters must now be direct to allens  
Fresh, she wishes me to give her a  
statement of the amount of sales of  
Miss Catharine Lameasters negroes  
which is as follows -
