

Dear Sister, Cobb Neck Oct 1<sup>st</sup> 1827

I Received Yours on the 30<sup>th</sup> Sept and you will inform Sister Agatha that the cause of my not writing to her before this was the expectation of leaving from Mr Combs St Marys County, and he answered my letter last Mail he says he will pay the note of as soon as he can make collection. Miss Ann Fenwick, I have been to porttobacco and obtained all the papers necessary from Father Keale I was in St Marys County last week to see Mr Day and he was not at home but saw his son whom informed me his Father was out then trying to collect the money that he expected to see me everyday if I do not hear from him in a few days I must go to see him again - and the case of Henry Keale I have taken James Brents note for the amount and I expect to see him next week

As for the Miss Fords I do not know what  
they intend to do for I sent the accounts down  
to them for payment and informed them that  
you were willing to give up the Interest  
and Mr Millars reply was very well but I  
expect no money will come until they are  
found, by law as soon as I can get  
money I will forward it but I fear it  
will not be very soon, we are all well  
and join in love to you and your good  
sister, tell Emily she must be good, I  
will write to her soon, so I remain  
your affectionate Brother Geo. Mads

write to me when ever she feels  
a disposition to hear from her business  
for I love to be pushed on, for it is  
a good plea for me to their creditors
