day sold and delivered to Elizabeth Matthews of the jurisdiction
of George Town in the District aforesaid, my Negro woman
named Kelly age unknown to me, which said negro woman
I warrant and defend a Slave for life, and for which I
have received one hundred Dollars in full consideration
thereof, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge
