

Whereas by deed of gift or instrument of that nature dated the thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty five, I gave to my daughter Martha Young my Negro Man Ignatius Tilyman son of my Carpenter Charles, and his wife named therein Susan and her issue: now to prevent any doubt or mistake as to who is meant under the said name of Susan, I declare that I meant thereby to give to my said daughter my servant woman correctly named Mary Elizabeth, but commonly called by the name of Susan and being the wife of said Ignatius. And for further security I give the said woman whether by the name of Susan or Mary Elizabeth to my said daughter, as well as the other servants aforesaid, all in consideration of the love and affection that I bear to my said daughter.
